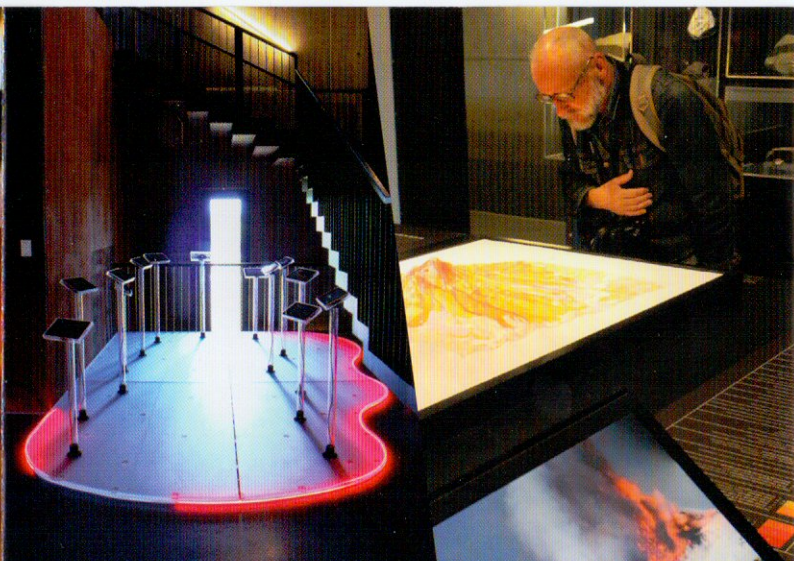




TAKE A TRIP

Visit the Kemenes Volcano Park in Celldömölk, at the foot of Ság Hill and you will definitely enjoy the exhibition displayed on five floors, presented with state-of-the-art interactive technology where visitors will be informed of volcanoes in an entertaining way via touchscreens and other smart IT gear.



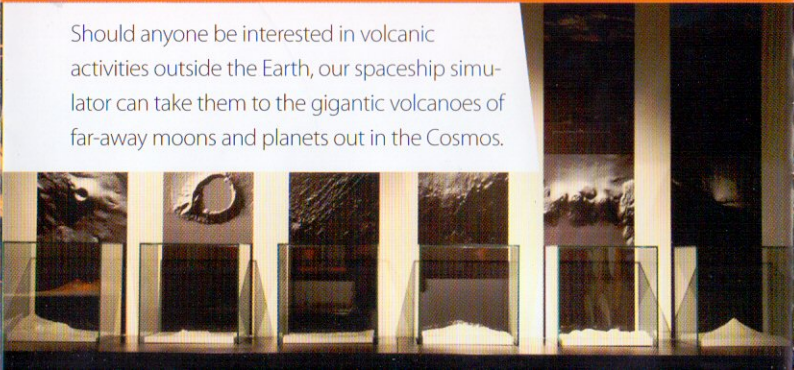
WOULD YOU LIKE TO BECOME A VOLCANOLOGIST FOR A DAY? **HERE, YOU CAN DO IT!**

In the Volcano Park you will find the explanation to how volcanoes evolve, what processes take place in their inside and, most importantly, what causes the eruptions.



While visiting the exhibition both adults and children can put themselves in the shoes of volcanologists – by putting on their special protective suit; they can see for themselves how much their kit – that they will have to carry on top of the volcano – weighs. Visitors may also take a glimpse inside a volcano and with the help of simulators, they can bring about an eruption of a volcano or a geyser or may even generate an earthquake. They can experience what it may feel like to be in the epicentre of an earthquake, they can see the devastation they can cause, and also understand why people still choose to live in the vicinity of volcanoes despite all the risks involved.

Should anyone be interested in volcanic activities outside the Earth, our spaceship simulator can take them to the gigantic volcanoes of far-away moons and planets out in the Cosmos.
